## No-Cost Home Energy Efficiency Assessment

Schedule an in-home assessment to identify ways to save energy today. Homeowners ready to invest in major upgrades can receive specific recommendations to improve your home's comfort and efficiency.

## Assistance with Home Energy Upgrade Projects

Your Energy Technician will help you determine what additional programs and services you may qualify for. Receive assistance to get started on the upgrades that are right for your home. Many homes qualify for up to **\$6,500 in rebates for energy upgrades**.

## No-Cost and Reduced-Cost Upgrades

Your home may be eligible for a variety of no-cost and reduced-cost upgrades, including: LED light bulbs, compact fluorescent lamps, low-flow faucet aerators, and low-flow showerheads.

## Take the First Step

All renters and homeowners in Humboldt County that are Pacific Gas and Electric Company customers are eligible for the No-Cost Home Efficiency Assessment. Fill out the application on the reverse and return it to the Redwood Coast Energy Authority. During the No-Cost Energy Efficiency Assessment we will determine your home's eligibility for: No-Cost and Reduced-Cost upgrades from Redwood Coast Energy Watch, appliance rebates, and whole-house upgrade rebates. We will also discuss solar rebates and financing options.

At the end of your Assessment we will provide you a quote of recommended No-Cost and Reduced-Cost upgrades detailing fees and incentives provided. In most situations a follow-up appointment will be scheduled to perform the installations that meet your approval, unless scheduling and stock allow for completion during the first appointment. Customers are not obligated to authorize upgrades.

Consult with our Energy Technicians to learn about further efficiency upgrade opportunities.
